

Restructuring of Capital Structure – Repurchase of Significant Financial Assets

Current Report No. 60/2008 of October 1st 2008

The Management Board of Impel SA reports that on on September 30th 2008 Impel SA acquired 20% of shares in TeleBT Sp. z o.o. of Wrocław (hereinafter referred to as the Company).

Impel SA purchased from two natural persons, shareholders of the Company, 40 shares with a par value of PLN 500 per share, and the total par value of PLN 20,000, representing 20% of the share capital and 20% of votes at the Company's GM. The total purchase price was PLN 20,000.

Ownership of the shares was transferred to Impel SA as from the date of signing a relevant agreement.

As a result of the share acquisition, Impel SA holds 40 shares with a par value of PLN 500 per share, and the total par value of PLN 20,000, representing 20% of the share capital and 20% of votes at the Company's GM. The remaining 160 shares of the Company with a par value of PLN 500 per share, and the total par value of PLN 80,000 – representing 80% of the share capital and 80% of votes at the Company's GM – are held by Impel Delivery Sp. z o.o. (wholly owned by Impel SA).

The transaction was financed with the Issuer's own resources. The acquisition results from execution of the Impel Group's strategy for optimizing internal IT and telecommunication processes.

The Management Board of Impel SA informs that there are no links between the Issuer, its managers and supervisors, and the persons disposing of the shares.

The shares acquired in the transaction have been classified as assets of significant value as they represent 20% of the Company's share capital.
